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Immunisation

The UK has a comprehensive immunisation programme for children: full details are available from the Medical Centre nurses or the pupils GP. Other countries may have a different programme. The immunisation status of all pupils is assessed when they join the school and specific advice is given as required.

The BCG (against TB) is now longer given routinely in the UK. The Medical Centre carries out a risk assessment on all pupils and individual guidance and referrals are made where necessary.

All pupils need a diphtheria, polio and tetanus booster between the ages 13-18. Parents are notified and the immunisation is given at the pupils own GP surgery.

Nurses can give general advice on travel vaccines but for a comprehensive assessment and detailed travel health recommendations parents should contact their own GP practice.
