Mill Hill International

Mill Hill International is located within its own newly refurbished part of the campus. Whilst focusing on academic development, we make sure that each pupil can exploit their talents so that their stay is both enriching and rewarding. Pupils come to Mill Hill International from a wide variety of cultural backgrounds, but they all share our commitment to study, a strong sense of purpose, and high expectations, creating a dynamic learning environment where every pupil can achieve.

Mill Hill International offers a broad range of academic programmes for Day and Boarding pupils aged between 13 and 17, lasting from one term to three years. Boarding pupils of both Mill Hill International and Mill Hill School reside in the same four boarding houses and enjoy greater integration through their activities, excursions and more. Sports teams are represented by pupils from both schools as are the drama and music productions.

Mill Hill Short Courses - Spring and Summer

Mill Hill's short courses in both spring and summer provide the perfect setting for learning and enjoyment. Our Spring and Summer courses are aimed both at students who will be joining British Boarding Schools and at those who wish to sample British education.

We offer courses to international boys and girls aged from 12 to 17. Our courses combine English Learning with Mathematics and Science or Sport. These core elements are complemented by a varied programme of creative activity classes including Music, Dance, Drama and Art.

Summer School operates throughout July and August, courses range from two to eight weeks in length. Spring School runs for one or two weeks in April.


