PLEASE STAY FOR PRESENTATIONS FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF THE TOURNAMENT.

This is a participation tournament:

1. All teams must be on the court and ready to play at the time stated on the order of play.
2. Captains should toss for centre pass prior to the start of the game.
3. **Please umpire your teams attacking end.**
4. Teachers/coaches are expected to provide an umpire to officiate their own matches.
5. In group A the matches are 14 minutes (7mins each way) with 2 minutes half time.
6. In group B the matches are 20 minutes (10mins each way) with 2 minutes half time.
7. There will be 2 minutes between each match.
8. No substitutions can be made during play except in case of an injury. In the event of blood on a player they must be substituted immediately.
9. Central timing will be in operation for each pool. A bell will sound at the start and end of the match. Matches will start and end on the umpire's whistle.
10. Bee Netball (Stinger) rules will apply throughout the tournament.
11. There will be no injury time, but umpires are requested to take care of an injured player accordingly.
12. Teams are asked to supply their own first aid kit, bibs and practice balls. Size 4 match balls will be used throughout the tournament.
13. No jewellery should be worn by any player and nails must be cut short.
14. Fingernails should be short and smooth – please make sure you check these.
15. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - 3 points = Win
 - 1 points = Draw
 - 0 point = A loss
16. In the event of teams finishing on equal points, places will be decided based on goal difference. If teams are still tied then places will be decided on goals scored, then goals against.

Registering

Please collect your School's envelope from the results table which contains the order of play and score cards.

There will be an Umpires Meeting at the score table at 9:20am.

During the tournament

- Please arrive from 9am onwards for a prompt 9:30am start.
- First aid provisions will be made available for all competitors at the score table, but please bring your own first aid as well.
- Please can the winning team return both score cards to the score table at the end of each match.
- Girls' changing rooms and toilets (pupils only) are located in the pink changing room. Adults only toilets are located in the Jubilee Hall. These are located just up from the two astros.

Group A will take place on courts 1, 2, 3 (large astro)

Group B will take place on courts 5 and 6 (small astro)

In the event of unfavourable weather, a decision will be made to cancel the tournament no later than 2pm on Friday 2nd March.

Rotations:

The Bee Netball rules for Stingers require players to rotate positions, this is to ensure that children learn and develop both attack & defence skills and maximise activity levels.

Requirements around frequency of rotations will be determined by local competition organisers. Often this will be at each half of the game although this will be determined by the type of competition. i.e a single match maybe different to a tournament.

Rotation sheets are available to help coaches, teachers and team managers organise the rotations within the team, some competition organisers may ask for copies of these.
