How to Register

-
- > For online registration please visit millhill.org.uk/Belmont. Go to 'Admissions' and the form can be found by clicking on 'Register your child'
 - > A non-refundable registration fee of £150 is payable for application made by residents of the UK and £200 for those UK residents overseas.

Overseas

Overseas applicants need to have the appropriate immigration permission to live in the UK and to study in the UK.

7+ Entry

(for girls and boys in Year 2 when tested)

-
- > Applications to be made by early-November
 - > References are requested from feeder schools in November
 - > Entrance tests at Belmont Mill Hill Prep School – Maths, NVR, reading test, story writing, interview and constructive play
 - > Testing takes place over one morning in mid-November
 - > Offer letters are sent out in February



11+ Entry

(for girls and boys in Year 6 when tested)

- > Applications to be made by mid-November
- > References are requested from feeder schools in November
- > Entrance tests at Belmont Mill Hill Prep School – computer based tests (Reading Comprehension, Verbal, Non-Verbal and Numerical Reasoning), group interview and problem solving and teamwork exercise
- > Testing takes place over one morning in late-November
- > Offer letters are sent out in February
- > If unsuccessful in 11+ tests, candidates can request their file is considered for the 13+ 'Year 8 Track' tests at Mill Hill School. You will have to register your child again and may have to sit tests again when they are in Year 8

11+ Scholarships and Awards

Academic Scholarships and Exhibitions

11+ applicants are automatically considered on the basis of a strong performance in their entrance examinations and those short-listed are invited to Scholarship interviews (held in the January after the examinations)

Music Exhibitions are available by separate application and assessment is by audition (held in the January after the examinations)



Bursaries

The Bursary policy and application forms are available on request from the Bursar. Email: bursaries@mhsfoundation.org.uk

- > Means-tested bursary awards of up to 100% are available to candidates from 11+ onwards
- > Applications should be made by the end of December preceding the year of entry
- > Information about the bursary application and assessment process is available at the 'Bursar's Surgery' on Open Mornings or by appointment



Additional Information

Extra Time and/or Laptop Use in 11+ Entrance Tests

These arrangements may be made on the basis of an educational psychologist's report, evidence from the candidate's current school and at the discretion of Belmont Mill Hill Prep School (details are available on request)

Admission to other Year Groups

Occasionally there are vacancies in other year groups and age appropriate testing will be arranged as these occur

Acceptance of an Offer

In order to accept an offer of a place, an Acceptance form (sent with the offer letter) must be completed and submitted at the same time as the non-refundable Acceptance Deposit of £2000
