Dr Roger Chapman BSc MB BS FRCGP (Chairman of the Court of Governors)

Dr Roger Chapman joined the Court of Governors of the Mill Hill School Foundation in 1998. He is a former pupil of Mill Hill School (1960-65). He qualified at St Bartholomew's Hospital in 1971 and was an NHS general practitioner in Leighton Buzzard for 36 years until retiring from practice in 2012. In addition to clinical practice he was very involved in post graduate training for general practice, medical regulation and medical politics, being Secretary of the Licensing Body for UK general practitioners from 1999 –2005 and representing colleagues through the BMA and representing UK general practice in Europe. He is the Chairman of the Court of Governors. He is also the Chairman of the Nominations and Governance Committee and Remuneration Committee. He served as Acting Chairman of the Court of Governors during the period June 2012 to June 2013 when Professor Michael Proctor, the then Chairman of the Court of Governors, was on sabbatical from Trinity College, Cambridge.

Mr Anthony L Brooke BA (Cantab) MBA (Deputy Chairman of the Court of Governors)

Anthony Brooke joined the Court of Governors of the Mill Hill School Foundation in September 2007. He is a former pupil of Belmont (1954 -1960) and of Mill Hill School (1960-1964). He read Natural Sciences at Christ's College, Cambridge, and has an MBA from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. Professor Eric W F W Alton MA MB BS MD FRCP FHEA FERS FMedSci

Professor Eric Alton joined the Court of Governors of the Mill Hill School Foundation in March 2015. Dr Amanda Craig MBBS DRCOG

She qualified at Middlesex Hospital Medical School in 1980 and is an NHS general practitioner in Brent.
